



Importer Security Filing “ 10 + 2” Program

On November 25, 2008, U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) published an interim final rule entitled “ importer Security Filing and Additional Carrier Requirements” in the Federal Register (73 FR 71730). The interim final rule requires both importers and carriers to submit additional information pertaining to cargo to CBP before the cargo is brought into the United States by vessel.

It is the importer’s responsibility to ensure that the ISF is filed and accurate. Starting in January 2010, failure to transmit the data elements on time will result in a \$5,000 penalty per violation.

Importers can file the ISF on their own or through a service provider **with a valid power of attorney.**
